Saturday April 27 — ANTIGUA

DAY 1 | Arrive to Guatemala City where you will be met and transferred to Antigua, the colonial capital of Guatemala, about an hour away, to enjoy the accommodations of Hotel Pensativo, your home for the next five nights.

Sunday April 28 — ANTIGUA

DAY 2 | The day begins with a walking tour of Colonial Antigua with our historian and arrives at the home of Amelia Palacios to see her Pre-Colombian through 20th and 21st C. art collection and learn about the planned museum - followed by lunch. The evening showcases a special art exhibition at Hotel Pensativo gallery – Artists from San Pedro La Laguna – followed by dinner. (B,L,D)

Monday April 29 — ANTIGUA

DAY 3 | Presentation by Latin American art curator Silvia Herrera followed by a studio visit to the home of contemporary artist Diana de Solares. We will lunch at the 16th century convent, Hotel Casa Santo Domingo, followed by a visit to the museums on the hotel grounds. The evening might include a visit to La Nueva Fabrica. Dinner is free. (BL)

Tuesday April 30 — ANTIGUA

DAY 4 | A short trip to San Juan del Obispo to experience the intimate gallery and the exquisite work of Guillermo Maldonado and Francesca Pizzo. After lunch an afternoon to shop and explore. The evening is spent at the home of Hugo Quinto and Juan Pablo Lojo for cocktails and dinner and to view their stunning, world class contemporary art collection. (BLD)

Wednesday May 1 — ANTIGUA

DAY 5 | After breakfast we will visit Arturo Monroy at his gallery/studio followed by Casa Del Mango gallery nearby. Lunch will be at a private home. And our last dinner in Antigua at Meson Panza Verde. (BLD)

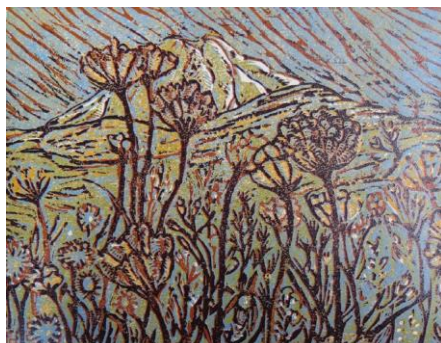
DAY 8 | A bittersweet departure. Or on to other parts of Guatemala – Lake Atitlan or Tikal? (B)

Travel Insurance: We recommend that you purchase health and travel insurance in the event of cancellation as personal travel insurance is NOT included in the Art & Artists of Guatemala tour.

Luggage: Luggage must be kept to a maximum of one large suitcase and a carry-on per person. We will oversee/manage luggage and work to locate/deliver any lost baggage, though we cannot be responsible for any loss.
